

Welcome to The Quarters Vineyard and Homestay.

We want you to enjoy your time with us and therefore with us being a working vineyard and farm, there are a number of things we would ask you to be mindful of for your own safety:

The property is fenced to ensure working zones for animals, vineyard etc. Please ensure all gates are closed at all times, in particular the main gates to the property. We would ask that you don't go into the animal paddocks as the cows are big girls and don't like running (which they will if you go in).

The vineyard is a multi hazard area, with tractors and other machinery likely to be in operation at any time, so we would ask that you do not enter it during working hours. After 5pm, if you would like to walk around the vines, we are happy for you to walk the headlands (the grassy areas around the perimeter of the vineyard) but please avoid walking down the vineyard rows or touching the grapes as they may have been organically sprayed.

Please don't touch the frost fan, tractor or any other equipment. If you would like to know more about them, please ask us if we are around.

The woolshed, although pretty to look at, contains equipment etc and is unsafe to enter, play in or around. Please do not let children climb on any equipment or play anywhere in the vineyard.

Be aware of uneven ground, low structures & branches and in windy conditions be aware of trees that may drop branches etc.

The entire property is **strictly** a no fire and no smoking zone. Please avoid littering of any kind on the property.

If you are staying in the Quarters Homestay, we operate on a septic tank system for all waste water so please ensure that the only things that are flushed down toilets are strictly natural or the toilet paper provided. We avoid the use of bleach or other disinfectants that can affect the environment. Please only use those provided in the Homestay bar area.

Water is a precious resource everywhere but particularly in sunny Marlborough. Please ensure any water taps used are fully switched off after use.

In the case of any emergency the gathering point will be at our front gate on Brancott Road.

If you spot anything that you think unusual (e.g fire, broken fence etc) we would appreciate you letting us know as soon as possible.
